The Society had established of 12th April 2010. the prime objective of the organization is to mobilize youth as vibrant human resource for the overall development of weaker and marginalized sections of the Indian Society. It has team of dedicated and committed young social workers, activists and volunteers. The organization strengthens effort for promoting sustainable and equitable social development. The society's focus is on motivating and mobilizing youth for the welfare and development. The organization strives to work for the welfare of one weaker section such as landless laborers, Marginal farmers, unemployed youth, street and working children, rehabilitation centre for destitute women, old age persons, health care centre, environment, education and workers in the unorganized sectors in India societies.

The Society being a non-political, non-profit making organization serving the people irrespective of caste, color and creed helped the people to stand on their own legs become self-reliant and sufficient. The organization has

been actively engaged in dealing with social issues such as poverty alleviations, community health, environment progression, and employment generation, population control, formal and non-formal education, youth women and children development, welfare of SC/ST & OBC. One of its main objectives is to create awareness among the people on social issues, mobilize them for social action and motivate them to work together social development. Since, women constitute the most deprived and exploited section of our society and require special attention for its rehabilitation, the organization gives impart training to women from all sections and make them self-dependent.

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PROGRAMMES AND ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN IN 2019-2020

The year 2019-2020 was very successful for the organization not only achieved its set targets but also expanded in new areas. To achieve its aims and objectives, it organized following programs and activities:

1. Computer Education:

Educational Programmes

The organization encourage for Computer Skills to the youth/children belong to the weaker section. Their Children/youths are getting computer education at a nominal fees. In

this educational this Organization provides the following Software programmes like Fundamental of computer, Notepad, WordPad, M.S.Paint, M.S. Word, M.S. Excel, M.S. PowerPoint, M.S.Excess, Adobe Photoshop, C,C++, Java and basic knowledge of internet and browsing. Our society organizes vocational training programme for welfare women, child and youths belonging to the informal economy. It is not just an organization but also a confluence of three movements- labor, self-reliance and self-employment. Our society started vocational training programme to encourage self-reliance and self-

employment for women and youths who were unemployed and searching job. In this programme society started all educated and uneducated persons in view of their requirements. Under vocational training programme our society-started computer training, typing, etc. This year we also start the programs for Women separately at Simdega Jharkhand, Maalbazar, West Bengal. Jamshedpur, Birbhum, Paradip Odisha



2 N.T.T.(Nursery Teacher Training)

Nursery Teacher Training means this Organization help for providing training to the Nursery Teachers. This training will help how to teach to the Nursery and Pre-Nursery children and in this course this must. Provides how to handle the Nursery students. This training helps the trainees for various job offers in Public School and Govt. School. After getting these trainees they can get job in Public school easily.

Balwadi Classes: The Society has conducted Balwadi Classes for poor children aged between three to five years at Srinivaspuri/Ashram in Delhi, Simdega, Jharkhand, Maalbazar, West Bengal. The prime objectives of the classes are to encourage children for attending the school at an early stage and aware their parents to send their child to school regularly for better education. The students has taught alphabets through games which also helps in their physical and mental development. Approximately 128 Children (male 70 & Female 58) attend the class and benefited by this program, 121 (Male 42 & Female 69) in Simdega, 184 (Male 84 & 100 Female) in Maalbazar, West Bengal.



3. Non-Formal Education for Children's

Education has been the most significant area of concern for the Organization. The Organizations hold classes of non-formal education for the children of weaker sections. These children were victim of all sorts of exploitation and abuse. Their parent did not realize the importance of education for their children. These parents preferred their children stay at home and help their parents in domestic activities. The organization motivates their parents to send their children to school. It also gives free of cost pre-exam coaching and guidance to the children belongs to schedule castes, schedule tribes and OBC. About 198 students attend the non-formal education in Srinivaspuri, Delhi. The classes is going with associate NGO Sahyog Deep Jyoti, NOW, Hero Jyoti Foundation, Adivasi Mahila Vikas Mandal, Delhi Tribal Forum, Aditya Vikas Samiti,

VOCATIONAL PROGRAMMES

The organization has offered vocational training to orphan and street children and unemployed youths for social upliftment. Its prime objective was to impart computer training to the poor & orphan children for creating Employment Avenue to them. Several poor children had received proper training from the centre and successfully employed in the urban areas. This year we have started the in rural areas of Jharkhand, West Bengal, Jammu & Kashmir, and Odisha.

1.Cutting & Tailoring: The organization has imparted skill development training on cutting and tailoring, exclusively women who are living below poverty line in Shrinivaspuri, Ashram Delhi, Bandipora of Kashmir, Malbazar of West Bengal, Baripada of Odisha, Kalebira of Jharkhand etc.

The trained volunteer provides high quality training to the participants by using various methods and tools. Large number of poor schedule cast women is unemployed to the people. Beside, trainees also get marketing facilities for selling their goods and self-employment opportunities in urban areas. Approximately 137 women benefited by this training. Cutting and tailoring is highly demand by the local people.

2.Beautician Course

The society has imparted beautician training to young girls and women in Srinivaspuri and Ashram area. The women participants received both practical and theoretical training by the national awardee trainers. The main focus of the training is beauty treatments like Eyebrow shaping, Pedicure, Manicure, Mehendi, Massage etc. The duration of the course six months, exam conducted every three months, about 95 participants passed in the examination. The organization given certificates to the participants and also provided them employment in Delhi. This year we have started at Malbazar of West Bengal, Bandipora of Kashmir, Baripada of Odisha and Kalebira of Jharkhand.



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1. Programs for Widows:

The organization has offered services to widows, by provide them literacy, vocational training, food facility and clothes. And also care the widows with the consultation of state govt. and old age home NGOs. Approximately 10 widows benefited by this programmes.



CULTURAL PROGRAMMES



Health & Family Welfare Programs

Health Programs

The society has organized health checkup camps time to time with help of Care Plus Diagnostics and Sara Diagnostics Center, New Delhi. The health checkup camp was held on 24th September, about 167 patients have been checked up and 40 patients were suggested for medical tests and 22 female patients being operated. Second camp held on 10th January, approximately 245 patients checked up, out of which 75 patients advised for medicines test. They also advised to visit OPD regularly and take medicines properly.

The organization has provided free health checkup to the poor, needy women and children. The family planning operations both male and female are done by MCD Doctors with the nominal charges Rs.300/- each patient. The camp also provided proper information to the pregnant women and infants about nutritious food and medicines.

2. Leprosy Colony:

The Society has distributed clothes the leprosy patients and also provided them medicines and methods of treatments. Approximately 422 leprosy patients benefited by this program. This year we have started in rural areas of Jharkhand, Odisha, West Bengal and Jammu & Kashmir

The Society was organized cultural programmes like drama, bhajan, dance and music at Srinivasपुरi. It was invited by the local artists to perform their roles; approximately 210 participants attend the cultural programme. To preserve our rich cultural heritage and traditions we organized dance, folk-song, drama etc. in which young and children participated in good number. Participants were also awarded for their presentation Drama, Dance competition, folk art festivals, Music etc. cultural Programme competition organized by society for entertainment of people and their welfare. Apart this a meeting organized of folk artists on the Gandhi Jayanti. The culture of a country is regarded as accumulated intellectual, emotional and spiritual wealth of that nation. We also do celebrate every year and organized Tribal Festivals KARAM, SARHUL, CHRISTMASS with the co-operation with ADIVASI MAHILA VIKAS MANDAL, DELHI TRIBAL FORUM in Delhi in different areas of Delhi. 14 lakh Tribals are living in Delhi and they enjoyed their culture. The present day our culture seems to be falling down, so we have the responsibility to preserve our culture and tradition through anyway whether we can do or not, So we organized many Programmes for it.

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Programmes For Handicaps

The organization extended help to the handicapped patients, by providing them treatment free of cost. The deaf children has sent to Lajpat Nagar, Diagnostics center for treatment and also provided Ear marlin free of cost and wheel chair those need. About 10 deaf patients received Ear marlin and 2 patients get wheel chair and certificates.



Welfare & Development Projects-2019-2020

The organizations undertake and implement welfare and development projects for people living in rural areas and urban slums. The main areas of our intervention are basis education and community health with special focus on women and children. We are mainly interested in empowerment local community by making them politically aware of their rights and giving them economic strength.

HEALTH AWARENESS PROGRAMME (HIV AIDS) 2019-2020

Our society is working on an array of problems - malaria, AIDS and so far all of which are big killers and don't have to be again. Our society's vision is to use our resources in a way that brings about the eradication of those problems with the help of AHF.

To minimize the problems of HIV/AIDS our society working for HIV/AIDS prevention and care work in WB, Odisha, Delhi, Jammu & Kashmir. The society's AIDS related work has unfolded over the last year in partnership with grass-roots school, college and health centers.



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SELF HELP GROUP

It is only through empowerment of women that development of a society and this is possible. Women empowerment means that they should break free of the world set by patriarchal norms. For that we organized a workshop for downtrodden women. Women help line was formed for doing survey of victim women and helping them to face challenge. Women SHG were also formed. In this financial year 5 SHG are formed. It is a group of 20 women, made for their self help. It is also known as "Mahilla Jagriti Group". The funds are collected by the group with their own contribution of Rs.100/-per women. The amount so collected is lent @ 1% p.a. to the needy women of the group. The repayment of loan is made in easy installment. A meeting, on monthly basis is called where the women discuss their problems and find their suitable solutions.



Candle Making

Our institution, 'NOC-FOUNDATION (NEW OPPORTUNITY FOR CHILDRENS)' provides training for different kids of candle making. All children, of the age group of 15 to 30, surrounding to our center, take part in this training, which helps for their self-employment. Under this training, the trainees are taught about all aspects of candle making beginning from the place of availability of materials to marketing of candles. This year we have started in rural areas of Jharkhand, Odisha, & West Bengal.

NETWORKING WITH OTHER NGOS

The organization has linkages and networking with many other NGOs working in different part of Delhi & NCR. (1. JEEJA BAI YUWATI MANDAL, 2. N.O.W., 3. DEEPALAYA, 4. Its main objective is to provide voice to the most neglected, deprived and exploited communities. We also Networking with some rural NGOs of JHARKHAND, ODISHA, CHHATISGARH, WEST BENGAL, ASSAM, SIKKIM, GUJARAT for the upliftment programmes for the Tribal Peoples.



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P.T.A. Meetings



P.T.A. Meetings are organized monthly by our institution in all four projects. In which parents of all children participate and we ask about the performance of children in studies. So many parents understand nicely & tell their problem. In last week of every month in 30th or 31st P.T.A. meeting are organized so that we can know how efficiently our institution is working. The members of our institution visit the colony weekly and take feedback from the people. People of colonies say that they are getting benefited because those who are poor, their children also getting education at lower fee and material for fun and entertainment are also arranged

COMMUNITY RELATIONSHIP GET-TOGETHER WITH TRIBAL COMMUNITIES IN DELHI

Migration and shelter active for empowering the tribal people more particularly the tribal women who are at the verge of migration and which those who have already migrated to various state of tribal belt. Tribal women are the most vulnerable targets group for abuse and oppression and are denied the most basic of human rights. Migrated girls and women who are working as domestic workers in Delhi and NCR are marginalized and have no access to basic education and skills enhancement due to which they are suffering day by day. They are facing, sexual harassment, sexual abuse, and victims of rape cases, theft and robbery. They are unable to express their state as they do not have right to say, and also do not know where to approach for their rights. They also do not say anything because of their family reputation etc. and in this way keep on bearing such circumstances. The dire need is to rescue them from various incidents and rehabilitate them from the situation and educate them, enable them to read and write so that they can raise their voice, train them on their human rights and the process through which they can proceed and enhance their skills to earn respectfully in the society. It will enable them to lead happy and prosperous lives. Keeping these views NOC FOUNDATION running rehabilitation cum training center and provide shelter for the victim. During the legal process the rescue victims are kept in shelter. In the shelter home their needs and rehabilitation training are taken care by the society.

Road safety campaigns are an important way to spread awareness among people about road safety measures and rules. The results of road safety campaigns depend however, first of all, on the manner of communication to road users. Since the target of the campaigns are people or groups of people, and as the characteristics of their behavior is different from one to another. While there is national concern about a variety of road safety issues (e.g., speeding, distraction, pedestrians, drinking and driving), the level of concern regarding each of these problems may vary across individual communities. In addition, road safety problems are local, meaning that the specific characteristics of a problem are often unique in each community. For example, the distraction problem in one community may be mostly related to drivers checking their phone at busy urban intersections at a red-light; in another community distraction may mainly involve cyclists and pedestrians who are using headphones. Road safety campaigns are flexible tools that communities can use to increase awareness and knowledge about specific road safety problems in their own community and can be adapted to a wide range of issues. Campaigns can be designed to target different audiences, are easily adapted to different media, and can be delivered for various lengths of time. They can also be delivered at local, regional, provincial or national levels. For these reasons, road safety campaigns have been used by jurisdictions around the world to reduce risky behaviors on the road and motivate positive changes in behavior.

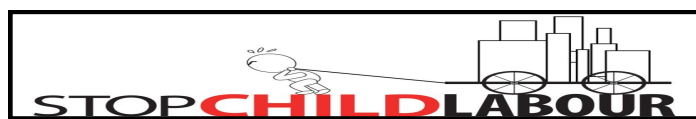
